applied ethics debates, such as “How do you make moral decisions in everyday life?”  
Faith-in-action projects to engage this group. Spent about an hour and a half and all  
parents volunteered to be part of a core committee.  
Get together again in June with this as a working group. Gear up for Fall.  
(Screening of volunteer instructors necessary.)
