Important Warning!

Please do not respond to any e-mail messages appearing to be from Fr. Ivan, our pastor, (or others) asking for gift cards or money without first checking with the person making the request. It could well be an internet scam.

Recently, Fr. Ivan's email was hacked. The scammer, purporting to be Fr. Ivan, asked people to send funds or gift cards. This is a scam: Fr. Ivan did not send this email. Unfortunately, the phony e-mail looks real.

When it comes to requesting donations,

- Fr. Ivan will not ask for any funds via e-mail: He will talk to you directly— in person or by phone.
- He won't ask for gift cards, but will ask for your help funding a specific church program or project.
- He will not insist that funds be provided immediately: There will always be time for consideration, discussion, and review.

Our staff e-mail ends with @calnewman.org. If you get an email note purporting to be from Newman staff that does not use that domain, do not trust it.

When in doubt, initiate a fresh email message, type in the correct email address yourself and email (or call) the person making the request.

We're getting into the holiday season when some will take advantage of our goodwill and generosity. Let's be alert to challenges of modern day giving and be sure we're sharing our treasure with causes we care about.



MISCELLANEOUS

October Mass Count: Mass attendance is up this year! On weekends in October, staff and volunteers diligently counted everyone who came to Mass. What did we learn? On average, 654 people attended our Sunday Masses (including the Saturday vigil at 5 pm). This is up nearly 20% from last year, when the number was 547, and shows an increase in both adults (361 attending Mass on average over a weekend, up by about 14%) and students (245, up by 7%). The number of children attending dropped a bit, however, from 32 on average over a weekend in 2022 to 19 on a weekend in 2023.

Which Masses drew the largest proportion of weekend worshipers? And, what proportion of adults and students attended which Masses? Check this space next week to find out.
