that dark forces that bring death do not lurk in history. But.. leaf through a history book, or even the newspapers, [and you will] discover the nefarious deeds of which we are partly victims and partly perpetrators: wars, violence, slavery, oppression of the poor, wounds that have never healed and continue to bleed. The virtue of fortitude makes us react and cry out "no", an emphatic "no" to all of this.....

There is a need for someone who can rouse us and make us resolutely repeat our "no" to evil and to everything that leads to indifference.... & "yes" to progress, to the path that moves us forward, and for this we must fight.

Let us therefore rediscover in the Gospel the fortitude of Jesus, and learn it from the witness of the saints. Thank you.




