Pope Francis continues his catechesis series on virtues and vices.


Dear brothers and sisters: In our catechesis on the virtues and the vices, we now turn to **envy and vainglory**. Envy, already present in the story of Cain and Abel, is a destructive force



fuelled by resentment towards others, and can lead to deadly hatred. The remedy to envy lies in Saint Paul's exhortation: "Love one another with brotherly affection, compete in esteeming one another" (Rom 12:10). Vainglory is marked by an inflated self-esteem, a craving for constant praise and frequently prone to using other people for one's own ends. Saint Paul's example of boasting of his weakness rather than achievements offers an effective way for overcoming vainglory. May we, like him, know that God's grace is sufficient, since his power is made perfect in weakness, and all the more gladly boast of our weaknesses, that the power of Christ may set us free for a more generous love of others.
