Healing is not always possible, but we can always care for the sick person. Saint John Paul II used to say, "Cure if it is possible; always take care" And this is where palliative care comes in. It guarantees the patient not only medical attention but also human assistance and closeness. Families should not be left alone in these difficult moments. They need access to adequate means so as to provide appropriate physical, spiritual and social support. Let us pray that the terminally ill and their families always receive the necessary medical and human care and assistance"


