In 1907, the Paulist Fathers were appointed to be full-time resident chaplains to the students at the University of California, Berkeley. In September of 1982, Fr. Al Moser, CSP was assigned as an associate pastor at Newman-Holy Spirit Parish. He has served student and resident parishioners here for 33 continuous years, until the age of 92 when he moved to Mercy Retirement & Care Center. From there he continued to grace us as a witness of the dignity and joy of aging gracefully. After one year there, on September 11<sup>th</sup> he returned to God, where he continues to bless us.

We are so blessed that Fr. Al ministered as long as he did here at Newman. In order to allow folks to honor Fr. Al for his dedicated years of serving our Lord at Newman and keep alive his memory and some of the key wonderful ministries he did, we are establishing a *Fr. Al Moser Campus Ministry Fund*.

This fund will be used to support ministries Fr. Al was noted for, like spiritual direction and student counseling, a discernment group, candlelight Mass, outreach to students, RCIA, faculty dinners and discussion, and the celebrating the sacrament of reconciliation. We also would like to use some of the funds to turn his former office into a Fr. Al Student Lounge, where students can have their own space to be together. The space at times might also function as a seminarian/intern office to train future Fr. Al's for the church. Fr. Al spent a number of years as the Paulist Formation Director, helping to form Paulist seminarians into priesthood.
